- Advise management on whether continued operation of equipment could be hazardous;
- Work in and maintain a working environment with an acceptable level of housekeeping;
- Use and maintain company provided tooling in accordance to working specifications and conditions;
- Monitor and record the use of workplace consumables:
- Assist in the training of apprentices and other staff;
- · Attend training when required; and
- Actively contribute to the organisation to produce quality salt, minimise costs, and maximise efficiency.

- Qualified Electrician, with a current Energy Safety WA electrical workers license;
- Successfully completed high voltage switching operations course highly desirable;
- · Current WA HR Licence highly desirable;
